**Schuylkill Expressway East (Route 76)** - Take the Conshohocken exit and go down the ramp to the light. Make a right turn onto Matsonford Road. Cross the Matsonford Bridge into Conshohocken. Turn left onto Conshohocken Road. After .8 of a mile watch for the flashing light at the crest of the hill, and turn left from Conshohocken Road (watch for the opposing traffic) onto Academy Drive. Follow the fence to the entrance to the parking lot. Turn right on Academy Drive. Follow the fence to the entrance to the parking lot.

**Schuylkill Expressway West (Route 76)** - Take the Conshohocken exit and go down the ramp to the light. Make a right turn onto Matsonford Road. Cross the Matsonford Bridge into Conshohocken. Turn left onto Conshohocken Road. After .8 of a mile watch for the flashing light at the crest of the hill, and turn left from Conshohocken Road (watch for the opposing traffic) onto Academy Drive. Follow the fence to the entrance to the parking lot. Turn right on Academy Drive. Follow the fence to the entrance to the parking lot.

**Blue Route North (Route 476)** - Take the Conshohocken exit and go down the ramp to the light. Make a right turn onto Matsonford Road. Cross the Matsonford Bridge into Conshohocken. Turn left onto Conshohocken Road. After .8 of a mile watch for the flashing light at the crest of the hill, and turn left from Conshohocken Road (watch for the opposing traffic) onto Academy Drive. Follow the fence to the entrance to the parking lot. Turn right on Academy Drive. Follow the fence to the entrance to the parking lot.

**Blue Route South (Route 476)** - Take the "Norristown" exit on 476 after the toll booths. The exit will put you on Ridge Pike headed for Norristown. At the fourth traffic light, turn left onto Conshohocken Road. After .8 of a mile watch for the flashing light at the crest of the hill, and turn left from Conshohocken Road (watch for the opposing traffic) onto Academy Drive. Follow the fence to the entrance to the parking lot.

**Pennsylvania Turnpike (Route 276)** - Traveling West Bound - Take exit to 476 South. Take the "Norristown" exit on 476 after the toll booths. The exit will put you on Ridge Pike headed for Norristown. At the fourth traffic light, turn left onto Conshohocken Road. After .8 of a mile watch for the flashing light at the crest of the hill, and turn left from Conshohocken Road (watch for the opposing traffic) onto Academy Drive. Follow the fence to the entrance to the parking lot.

**Pennsylvania Turnpike (Route 276)** - Traveling East Bound - Exit at the "Norristown" exit #333. Take the first exit "Plymouth Meeting" - "Germantown Pike East" after the toll booth. Go under the bridges to traffic light and turn right onto Chemical Road. At the fourth traffic light on Chemical Road turn right onto Ridge Pike. At the fourth traffic light on Ridge Pike turn left onto Conshohocken Road. After .8 of a mile watch for the flashing light at the crest of the hill, and turn left from Conshohocken Road (watch for the opposing traffic) onto Academy Drive. Follow the chain link fence to the entrance to the parking lot.

<p><b>Police EVOC Skills and Skid Control for SUVs</b></p> <p>Class size limit: 14</p> <p>Officers attending should report in old clothes by 8:30 a.m.</p> <p>Officers must bring a police department owned SUV or prisoner van to drive on the driving range. Vehicles will not be used for the skid control exercises.</p>	<p>This one (1) day course is designed for officers who have already completed a Basic EVOC course including police academy training. It will provide students with an in-depth understanding of the capabilities and limitations of police vehicles in skid situations using the EVOC Program's SUV SkidCar. Students will gain an understanding of a proactive driver defined as one who uses superior knowledge to avoid situations that require superior skill. They will also gain a better understanding of their individual ability to effectively operate the vehicle in patrol, response, and pursuit driving situations. In addition, students will gain a rudimentary understanding of the basic concepts of vehicle dynamics as they apply to the vehicle and driver. Students will spend the majority of time behind the wheel sharpening their driving skills including braking, evasive and backing evolutions. Students must successfully complete written and practical exams to receive certification for the course.</p>
<p><b>Vehicle Stops – Daytime</b></p> <p>Class size limit: 12</p> <p>Officers should bring their duty belt, holster and bullet proof vest.</p>	<p>This one (1) day course is designed to introduce police officers to techniques that will assist the officer to safely and successfully deal with routine and high risk vehicle stops during daytime conditions. Students will spend a 1/2 day in the classroom and 1/2 day on the driving course. Students must successfully complete written and practical exams to receive certification for the course.</p>
<p><b>Police EVOC FOR SUV's</b></p> <p>Class size limit: 20</p> <p>Officers attending should report in old clothes by 8:30 a.m.</p> <p>Officers attending must bring a police department owned SUV or prisoner van to drive on the driving range.</p>	<p>This one (1) day course is designed for officers who routinely are assigned to drive a SUV or prisoner transport vehicles. This course will provide officers with an opportunity to apply the skills they learned during the Basic EVOC course while driving a larger vehicle. Defensive driving techniques and emergency response tactics will be demonstrated to and practiced by those attending. The course will be 1/2 day behind the wheel driving skills that includes a response course as well as a skill course that will include backing. Students must successfully complete written and practical exams to receive certification for the course.</p>
<p><b>Vehicle Stops – Night</b></p> <p>Class size limit: 12</p> <p>Officers should bring their duty belt, holster and bullet proof vest.</p>	<p>This one (1) day course is designed to introduce police officers to techniques that will assist the officer to safely and successfully deal with routine and high risk vehicle stops during nighttime conditions. Students will spend 1/2 day in the classroom and 1/2 day on the driving course. Students must successfully complete written and practical exams to receive certification for the course.</p>
