Directions from:

Schuylkill Expressway East (Route 76) - Take the Conshohocken exit and go down the ramp to the light. Make a right turn onto Matsonford Road. Cross the Matsonford Bridge into Conshohocken. Turn left onto Conshohocken Road. After .8 of a mile watch for the flashing light at the crest of the hill, and turn left from Conshohocken Road (watch for the opposing traffic) onto Academy Drive. Follow the fence to the entrance to the parking lot. Turn right on Academy Drive. Follow the fence to the entrance to the parking lot.

Schuylkill Expressway West (Route 76) - Take the Conshohocken exit and go down the ramp to the light. Make a right turn onto Matsonford Road. Cross the Matsonford Bridge into Conshohocken. Turn left onto Conshohocken Road. After .8 of a mile watch for the flashing light at the crest of the hill, and turn left from Conshohocken Road (watch for the opposing traffic) onto Academy Drive. Follow the fence to the entrance to the parking lot. Turn right on Academy Drive. Follow the fence to the entrance to the parking lot.

Blue Route North (Route 476) - Take the Conshohocken exit and go down the ramp to the light. Make a right turn onto Matsonford Road. Cross the Matsonford Bridge into Conshohocken. Turn left onto Conshohocken Road. After .8 of a mile watch for the flashing light at the crest of the hill, and turn left from Conshohocken Road (watch for the opposing traffic) onto Academy Drive. Follow the fence to the entrance to the parking lot. Turn right on Academy Drive. Follow the fence to the entrance to the parking lot.

Blue Route South (Route 476) - Take the "Norristown" exit on 476 after the toll booths. The exit will put you on Ridge Pike headed for Norristown. At the fourth traffic light, turn left onto Conshohocken Road. After .8 of a mile watch for the flashing light at the crest of the hill, and turn left from Conshohocken Road (watch for the opposing traffic) onto Academy Drive. Follow the fence to the entrance to the parking lot.

Pennsylvania Turnpike (Route 276) - Traveling West Bound - Take exit to 476 South. Take the "Norristown" exit on 476 after the toll booths. The exit will put you on Ridge Pike headed for Norristown. At the fourth traffic light, turn left onto Conshohocken Road. After .8 of a mile watch for the flashing light at the crest of the hill, and turn left from Conshohocken Road (watch for the opposing traffic) onto Academy Drive. Follow the fence to the entrance to the parking lot.

Pennsylvania Turnpike (Route 276) - Traveling East Bound - Exit at the "Norristown" exit #333. Take the first exit "Plymouth Meeting" - "Germantown Pike East" after the toll booth. Go under the bridges to traffic light and turn right onto Chemical Road. At the fourth traffic light on Chemical Road turn right onto Ridge Pike. At the fourth traffic light on Ridge Pike turn left onto Conshohocken Road. After .8 of a mile watch for the flashing light at the crest of the hill, and turn left from Conshohocken Road (watch for the opposing traffic) onto Academy Drive. Follow the chain link fence to the entrance to the parking lot.

<p>Basic Police Motorcycle Operator</p> <p>Class size limit: 12</p> <p>Officers attending must be properly licensed to operate a motorcycle and must bring a Police Department owned motorcycle, DOT approved helmet, leather gloves (not fingerless gloves), ankle or higher boots, eye protection (wrap around preferred), and rain gear.</p>	<p>This ten (10) day, 80 hour course is designed for Police Officers who are assigned to Police Motorcycle Patrol duties. This course will introduce these officers to the uniqueness of Motorcycle Patrol.</p> <p>The course will cover machine nomenclature, slow maneuvering, control, curve negotiation, motorcycle maintenance, night operations, defensive driving techniques and on the street riding. The course will involve classroom instruction and street driving. Students must successfully complete written and practical exams to receive certification for the course.</p>
<p>Police Motorcycle Operator Recertification</p> <p>Class size limit: 20</p> <p>Officers attending must be properly licensed to operate a motorcycle and must bring a Police Department owned motorcycle.</p>	<p>This three (3) day course is designed for officers who have already completed the Basic Police Motorcycle Operator Certification course.</p> <p>This course will provide officers with an opportunity to update the skills they learned in the basic course. Students <u>must attend all three days</u> to receive their recertification. Students must also successfully complete written and practical exams to receive certification for the course.</p>
